Services we provide:

- Dog walking or accompanied walking via our volunteers or others
- Advice and practical support via our volunteers to enable a pet to stay with its owner
- Regular visits from a volunteer with their own dog
- Support around bereavement and acknowledging the impact of loss
- Fostering pets in times of crisis
- Sourcing, introducing and monitoring a new pet

Who we help

We help people and their animals regardless of their age and where they live with our current focus on the West Suffolk area. Pets can be vital companions especially for the vulnerable or isolated and may be their only family.

We help individuals with mental or physical frailty who have, or have had, pets as companions, but who can no longer keep them – or need support to keep them.



We are the eyes and the ears for the hidden vulnerable

A key aspect of Our Special Friend's approach is working in close collaboration with partner health and welfare organisations to optimise outcomes for people and animals. We often find clients in desperate situations, too anxious to contact statutory services for fear that their beloved pet will be taken away. Our focus on the human-animal bond and innovative position bridging the divide between human and animal services means clients feel able to turn to us in these situations.
